



Competition Prep Class

Sometimes offered during the spring session (Session IV) and occasionally at other times of the year, this class prepares skaters for Learn to Skate competitions. We require that it can only be taken by skaters who have also enrolled in their regular badge level class during the same session at the North Shore Skating Club's Learn to Skate program. Since skaters usually compete at the level they have passed, this class gives skaters the opportunity to review and prepare the required elements for competitions while also enabling them to proceed in learning new skills in their regular class. Divided by level, the instructor will work with each skater to perfect the skills at the skater's competition level and help them prepare for upcoming Learn to Skate Competitions.

Each year we host the North Shore Skating Club's Annual Compete USA Competition (usually on the second Sunday in June). Skaters of all ages and levels in our Learn to Skate Program and others in the local area may choose to compete. There are competitive events for skaters in Snowplow 1 through Free Skate 6 and Hockey Skating 1 through Power Hockey as well as events for adults at the Adult 1 through Adult Bronze level. All competitors will receive a medal and the emphasis will be on FUN!!!
